



Co-Curricular Sport/Activities Agreement

Sporting and extra-curricular activities are offered at Southland Boys' High School in order to enrich students' experience of school and develop their potential.

Students will abide by the principles of fair-play and exhibit the school's values when representing Southland Boys' High School:

- Courtesy through sportsmanship and respect of the game, the opposition and the officials.
- Commitment through taking part in every training session and effort at practices.
- Curiosity through improving skills and abilities at individual level.
- Courage through wearing the correct sports uniform, playing gears and putting the team above oneself.

Players, coaches and managers and caregivers would not question the officials.

Students will abide by the principle of 'no pay/no play' regarding sport/activity fees.

Parents/caregivers are expected to set a positive example to students and players by showing courtesy and respect on the sideline to the opposition and officials.

Parents/caregivers should support their children in a positive manner.

Should parents/caregivers be unable to transport their own son to an 'away' game/fixture, they give permission for their son to be transported safely to and from fixtures by school-organised transport and/or with a responsible person with a full driver's license provided with the approval of a coach and/or teacher in charge of the team.

By signing the Co-Curricular Sport/Activities Agreement, students and parents/caregiver acknowledge that they fully understand and agree to the conditions outlined above.
